I could see after prayer

My name is Dipok Hazarika. I was born in the year 1981 from a Hindu family. I studied upto class X. while i was young, I joined the ULFA militant group. During that time I was assigned as an intelligence officer and sent to Nagaland.

One day, during my duty at the Railway station of Dimapur, I was arrested by the Indian Army and sent to Dimapur jail. After some days I was sent to Assam jail, where I spent my 3 and half years. After my release in 2014 I joined the National four lane Highway Company, during this period I got married. One day while traveling we got in an accident. I was severely injured in the head and was rushed to the Hospital. I was operated on by the Doctors. Luckily I was saved from death. But due to the severe injury, I had gone blind. So the Doctors gave me a certificate of blindness for both my eyes, which is still with me. Since I had gone blind, I could not continue to work. Soon enough we ran out of money and I could not provide for my family. My children were crying for food. I was so helpless, I looked for help but even my friends and relatives refused to help me. I started going to different temples but they also failed to help me. They did all the prayers and pujas but it didn't help my eyesight recover. All these had failed.

I decided that the only way to give food for my family is to go begging, in the nearby places where I knew. I couldn't go far because of the unfamiliarity. People would shut their doors by seeing my face and even shout, telling me to go away from their compound. One day i got no alms so I continued to beg and went a bit far from my usual area. I happened to enter a house which was owned by a christian family.

These people were very unusual and they talked to me very well. They asked about me, how my eyes went blind. They told me about Jesus which I never heard from anyone before. They said that Jesus was the one who died on the cross for us (sinners) and rose up from the grave on the third day. So whosoever believes in him shall not perish but will have everlasting life. Not only that but he can heal all kinds of sicknesses. So I agreed, and they prayed for me. So I was so anxious to see the result of their prayer. And after prayer, my eyes could see, it was really a wonderful miracle in my life that day. It was at the Ganeshguri Christian prayer house Guwahati in the year of 2008. They helped me to go to church every Sunday besides giving food for my family. They told me to wait a little to take water Baptism. But I could not wait anymore. So they gave me water baptism quickly.

I organized a healing crusade at Vijayanagar, Guwahati. About 800 people came to the crusade. Mr. Doron Dol od Arunachal came with his team. Many sick people were healed. I told my own story how Jesus healed me from both the blind eyes certified by Doctors. Praise God for all those. After seeing those miracles of healing, I was asked to go as a speaker at Garo Hills youth crusade. It was about six months only after my conversion by miracles. And I know nothing



about the speaker, chairman at all. When I reached there they were announcing on the mic that our speaker had arrived. I thought that P.A Sangma the former speaker of India was also in that crusade. So they might be talking about him. When the time came, they asked me now your time has come, please take your time as a speaker. I told them I came alone and I didn't bring any type of speaker or microphone. Because I thought that the speaker must be talking about mic/loud speakers. But they said in a calm way, to speak the word of God. only by that time i came to know all about the speaker. I stood up knowing nothing without any preparation. I do not know what I was saying either, but I saw many people fall down on the ground. Now I was afraid many youths might have fractured their legs or arms. And I might be arrested if I don't go back home. But praise God, nothing such happened but many could not stop praying and praising God. Today I can see and serve as an evangelist in Assam.

My name is Jeremiah Marak and I am from Dibrugarh, Assam. In the family, I am the only child of my father and mother. I was born in a christian family. I took baptism in 2018 when I was 6 years old. That time I didn't know about Jesus Christ or what Baptism is.

When I was studying with my friends I used to have intoxicants and I used bad language. And when going to school, on the road I used to run away with my friends to do bad things. OUTREACH REPORT TO NEPAL

Our journey began on the 4 of april 2019 from Nagaland. We reached in Dulabari, Nepal on the 5 April 2019. To reach our destination we moved out at night for Chuka West Nepal and reached the next day.

We attended the CRC conference there in CRC Chuka. This church is also one of the biggest churches in West Nepal.

In Chuka, the biggest cement factory in Nepal is being constructed by the Chinese Government. There we saw many construction workers who were Chinese Nationals.

Our next journey was to Botwal CRC church. On 77 April, our group did a dedication ceremony for a prayer center named Batesa Prayer Center.

The same night we left for Kathmandu and reached the next day. We had a wonderful meeting with the believers and the elders of the Kathmandu CRC, Moupani.

In April we left for Gangtok Sikkim. A gentleman named Er. Laxman told us that he is willing to donate a plot of land for Bible College. So we surveyed the land at Sambaria, Sikkim.

The same night we came to pastor Kedikhel Pucho's home at Tharpu and stayed the night. The next morning we left for Tomson, after crossing Pokhora Nepal. On our way there we saw a Tata sumo which was stuck while crossing a river. We prayed for them and helped rescue them out of the water. Since they had no place to stay the night, we took them to a place where we were supposed to stay. The next morning they thanked us and told us that we were real examples of the Christian faith. We also witnessed the owner of the Hotel, and prayed for her family as she requested us. The power of God touched her and she wept joyfully.

On 13 April, we went to the China border. After crossing the China border we prayed for the Gospel to reach China. Up in the mountains it was full of snow and many rivers were frozen. Across the mountain, we also saw many beautiful Chinese houses. It was difficult to breathe because of the high altitude. The mountains were full of rocks and not much green vegetation or plants were seen. Some areas look alike to where we traveled from Israel to Egypt. The scenery was so beautiful.



As we traveled we kept singing and praising Jesus, all of a sudden the anointing of the Holy spirit came upon us and tears filled our eyes. We also came across some shepherds who owned 5000 sheeps. We came across these following places on our way Chusang, Solonthang, Numanthang, Gaming, Zeling and Korala under Mustang district of Nepal which is the last Nepal village bordering Tibet.

On 14 April we left for Dulabari, West Nepal. Then the same night we left for Nagaland and reached on 15 April.

OUTREACH REPORT TO MYANMAR

On 12 Sept. by God's grace, 8 of us traveled to the Myanmar border after crossing Meluri. We were able to distribute Nagamese Bible to 9 villages namely, Sera, Miilongla, Sapiya, Tenlinwe, Melongri, Wopami, Amimi, Leshi and Lakpe in Myanmar and 11 villages in Nagaland. We were also able to give a few Bibles to the Indian Army stationed at the International check gate. 160 Bibles were distributed but it was not sufficient to give all those who wanted the Bible.

On 31 sept. We had a fellowship with CRC Meluri and Phukhungri Baptist Church on 15 sept. The next Nagamese seminar will be held at Longwa village of Mon district on 17 to 20 October 2019. And Pangsha village of Tuensang district on 26 to 30 November 2019. And on 16 to 20 December 2019 at Dipizuonung village of Le-Hey township Myanmar there will be a prayer house dedication and Bible seminar.

OUTREACH REPORT

It was already winter and Christmas was approaching and IMTI students and staff venture to go to Batesa prayer center in West Nepal. We had earned some money by sellings pickles, soaps, brooms (jharu) and flowers along with pots.

We were there for one week and started construction of a double storey building. We also hired some workers (Mistiri). They also stayed with us in the jungle where no other house was there except for three temporary sheds while we were there.

We could witness those workers who were Hindus by birth till that day.

It was on the 4 December 2018 night we told them about Jesus Christ, how he died on the cross and rose on the third day, who is also coming back to take those who are believing in him to heaven. The Mysteries believed Jesus and made a decision that night. Their names were Mr. Top Narain and Mr. Sandip Choudhury. Therefore that very night they kneeled down and we prayed for them. By God's grace the prayer house was dedicated by Rev. Amos Gajmer, President of Nepal CRC council on 7 April 2019. We praised God for that.



We also went to Myanmar (Burma) from 13 to 18 December 2018 just after W. Nepal programme of outreach works. From Pungro of Kiphire district, we have to go by vehicle for about 3 hours journey and reached Sangtson village. There we had food, our tiffin which was prepared from Dimapur. It was already 1 pm, the vehicle could not go through anymore because of no road. We started walking by 1 pm, we went through Luthur village, Pinkim village, Thruntsumong village, Vontsuvong village and at last by 9pm we could reach Tipizuonung village after walking for 9 hours. We praise God for the villagers who brought us water, food and even torch light in the jungle. We were strengthened and we continued walking until we reached the place where we wanted to construct the prayer house. We were there for 3 days and returned from a different route crossing Mokokchung village. This time we came by motorbike taxi. But it was more difficult than walking by foot because two people traveled on a motorbike through the jungle foot path upto the mountain and down to the river crossing the popular mountain Saramati. We got down at the border village of Sangchong without any injury even though we fell down from the motorbike many times on the jungle paths.

Once I was in Assam for church service. They were celebrating New year in Feb. i asked them why? They said they had no money to buy meat and that's why they celebrated in Feb. in 2014 I celebrated New Year 2 times. 1 jan. and the other in Assam in Feb. Last sunday the 16 June 2019 we went to Assam and attended 3 services and gave gift to 5 churches. Me and Er. D. Zhasa we went to Chalakathar and I went to Lekthe and then to Chalakathar and had lunch. We reached at 2 pm and had service and gave gifts to the church at 9 Mile, Hidipi, Khatkati CRC and we bought back 6 gifts and gave to the church members on wednesday service in our (GMC) Garden Mission Church.
