(who became second king direct from Jail)

Joseph's life can be broadly divided into three:

1. Childhood or young life period or dreaming period i.e. 1-17 years of age: (Genesis 37:1-36). During this period he was with his father and mother at home. His father loved him more than any of his brothers because he was the son of his old age. For which he made a special coat for him as a sign of special love. During those days he dreamt that they were binding a paddy in the field . and his paddy sheaves rose up, all the others came and worshiped his sheaves and another dream was that sun and the moon came and bowed down to me and his father was rebuking him for his Dreams.
2. Youth life, suffering period i.e 17-30 years=13 years: one day his father asked him to go and see his brothers in the jungle who were watching over their flocks (sheep) day and Night. So Joseph obeyed his father and went from hebron valley to shechem and from there to Dothan. When his brothers saw him coming, let us kill him and see how his dreams will come true. But Reuben said to them shed no blood but can cast him into this pit and do not lay a hand on him, so they obeyed the suggestion and put him in the pit that time some israelites business people passed by, so they sold out joseph by twenty shekels of silver. And they took Joseph to Egypt. And he was resold to potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh and Captain of the Guard. So Joseph was a servant in Potiphar's house . and the lord was with Joseph so he was Successful ma. His mastere saw that the Lord was with him and the Lord made all he did to prosper in his hand. The lord blessed the Egyptians house Potiphar for Joseph's sake. A big temptation came to Joseph as his master's wife was after Joseph as he was a handsome boy. But Joseph always refused and said how can I do this wickedness and sin against God.but one he was caught by his clothes by force to lie down with her. But he left his clothes and went away so she falsely reported that she caught his clothes while he was trying to lie with her. So Joseph was sent to jail for his Righteousness. While he was in jail by God's Grace he Could interpret the dream of butler and friend. So it came to happen that Pharaoh had a dream but nobody could interpret his dream. But it was told that Joseph, one of the Hebrew boys, could interpret his dream. So Joseph was brought from jail to Pharaoh's place to interpret the dream. Therefore let pharaoh the king store up all the harvest one part five of all the harvest income in order to survive by the time of famine. 3. The parenthood period of the later age period or the glorious age period (30-110)= 80 years): now Joseph Become second or next to king (governor) in

Egypt (Gen. 42:6) and he started up all one fifth of the Good grains harvest for the first seven years. Gen. 41:34) Now the famine was severe not only in Egypt but all over the face of the earth (Gen. 41:56) so people came from all over the countries to buy grain in Egypt. Jacob (Israel) also sent his sons to Egypt to buy grain. So they came and bowed down before Joseph. But none of his brothers came to know that it was Joseph, their own brother whom they had sold out for twenty pieces of silver. Joseph knew all his brothers and remembered his dreams while he was young. Joseph's life was full of suffering during those 13 years of life but he really enjoyed the glorious life for the late part of 80 years of his life. "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness sake for there is kingdom of heaven" Matthew 5:10

FIRST OUTREACH IN NEPAL

It was way back in 1991, when the shower ministry international organized a seminar at Kathmandu. Brother Neil Anderson invited ten ministry to attend the same as he happened to come across the Ten Magazine, during 1990's we the ten of us namely, Naro, Sadeleii, Chimboi, Neiu, Beinuo, Sanuo, Sakholie, Razou, A.B. Chettri and myself (Dr. Kip Rio) as the ten team leader, we attended the three day's seminar at Kathmandu. After the seminar, we went to A.B Chettri's place called Boroghat of West Nepal. It took the whole day from Kathmandu to Boroghat. We told them to tell the villagers that young Nagas have come to Boroghat and they are going to sing songs for Nepali people. Therefore anybody can come and listen to the songs. A deft man also came to listen to the songs. And miraculously that deft man was able to hear the song and music. In this place, there was no space to have a meeting. So we had the first gospel song meeting conducted at cowshed which was quite good and miraculous. When we started singing, more and more people started coming and they requested us to sing more and more, as it was their first time in their life to hear such beautiful songs. And they didn't give us a chance (time) to have dinner as they refused to go back home. And requested us to sing again and again. So we had dinner turn by turn, while some people were singing and some were having their dinner. And it was already midnight but we were still singing. Praise the Lord slowly God did so many things here. And they could start a fellowship.

When the first church building started, we made juice and bread and sold it in Dimapur, Nagaland. The Metha's family also contributed a lot of money in the C.R.C church construction. Nowadays, this church is looking after Batase prayer center and God is doing so many miracles here. This prayer center was started by one old man who killed his own father and ran away to Nagaland and from here he was converted. When he came here as the Lord led him, he made a shed with tree leaves and started fasting and praying. Slowly people from Nepal both christian and non christian came especially for healing. During 1998 to 2010 Rev. Panlau Patton was sent as missionary to this area in West Nepal, sponsored by the House of prayer for all nations (HOPFAN) Dimapur. During those days few C.R.C churches were established in Nepal. Praise the Lord and thanks to Rev. Patton. May God bless you and your work mightily.

OUTREACH REPORT

By the grace of God, Evangelist Vilhou (Chinba) and I (Dr. Kip Rio) left for Nepal on 9 May 2018 from Dimapur. We reached Dulabari, Nepal on 10 May 2018 and attended the foundation day celebration at Kharkhola CRC. This church is the only church that observe on Saturday. We gave them some amount of money to buy big plates and give to all the mothers on mother's day. On the same evening, we left for Kathmandu CRC Malpani, Tewarital. We celebrated mother's day and gave gifts (detergents) which were prepared by my wife to all the mothers. I shared the topic of a good mother. A good mother will take all her children to church always and have family prayer always every morning or evening. Referring 1 Peter 5:6-7, "Humble yourself, therefore under the mighty hand of God, so that at the proper time he may exalt you". Casting all your cares on him because he cares for you. I also shared about my mother, how she taught me even though she was illiterate. She taught us a good lesson on how to work. My mother told us (me and my sisters) to go to the field to watch the birds who come to eat the ripen paddy. My sister got ready but I was too lazy to go. So my mother picked up a handful of soil and pressed it into my mouth and said if you are too lazy to work, eat this soil. Lazy people who do not like to work should not eat food but soil. (II Thessalonians 3:10, when I shared this story of my own good mother, we all burst into tears).

After that we also had the Lord's supper with bread and wine which were brought from Jerusalem last month (18 to 28 April) and also we could give anointing olive oil brought from Jerusalem to Rev. A.B Chetri, Rev. Anos Gajmeer and missionary Mhasilhouseie to be used for healing of sick people.

Then on 13 May 2018 i.e Sunday we went up to a mountain village called Lakhuripunjan with a prayer group that used to go to the jungle and pray at least once a month. Here I could share about the power of resurrection. Friday was the day Jesus was crucified and he shed his blood for the sins of people. Saturday was the day Jesus was in the grave. But rose up from the grave that people all over the world respect and observe on Sunday but not in Nepali. Therefore we the Revival people should learn the powerful day of resurrection day of Sunday. And the prayer group should pray that the Christian people of Nepal should turn from powerless to powerful Christian.

On 14 May 2018 we three of us left for Chinba's (Vilhou) village i.e Sindujakhigoan which is two hours journey from Kathmandu. We spent the night there and had a meeting with them. Until now, no one is Christian except for Vilhou, who left his village 55 years ago and went to Nagaland. His relatives are willing to give him a plot of land to establish a prayer house. We prayed for his relatives and villagers and returned to Kathmandu on 15 May 2018.

On 14 and 15 May 2018 Nepal CRC council members did all the prayer works in relation to Kathmandu C.R.C plot of land and we got it done.

On 16, three of us left the Bordaghat West Nepal and we reached Batase prayer center. An old man named Subha who was once working in Nagaland is here in this prayer house, and I told

him to observe Sunday service always and we spent the night in Bordaghat C.R.C church and left on 17 for Kathmandu. I preached on (Matthew 11:28) “come unto me all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and i will give you rest”. “Take my yoke upon you and learn from me. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” (John 3:16, For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son that whosoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life). Jesus was the only God who was crucified on the cross and shed his blood for the remission of the sins of the world and rose up again on the third day. There are so many Gods but only Jesus died and rose up again, who is coming back again to take all who believe in him to heaven. Then we visited a plot of land for construction of a church and prayer house and the remaining for a cemetery. After that we left for Kathmandu by walking to the main China border road which takes about three hours.

The next day i.e 20 May 2018 sunday we had first sunday prayer service at Kathmandu CRC and told them to continue every sunday service. Then we went to Kotunje, Boktopur which is about half an hour drive from Mulmani CRC. we surveyed the area for a prayer garden where we can have a prayer house, Hospital etc. the place was very nice and nearby Grace Mahima Church where pastor Mon Chettri is pastoring where we had a sunday prayer here and told him to continue Sunday service. Then we left for Dulabari East Nepal.

The next day, 22 May before leaving for Nagaland we went to one of our Nagaland C.R.C Missionary’s places (Alodi) where they used to have fellowship. But in 2014, Earthquake came and it caused cracks in the rented room where they used to have fellowship. So they did not hold fellowship till date after the Earthquake. We prayed for them and told them to restart the fellowship, which they agreed promptly. Then we left for Nagaland.

HOLY LAND TOUR REPORT

By the grace of God,19 of us members of the Nagaland Christian revival Church, started our journey from Dimapur on 18-28 april 2018, under the leadership of NCRC president Rev. Dr. N. Paphino. New Delhi to Kuwait and to Amman Capital of Jordan by Flight. It was Already evening on the 19 april 2018 we tried to enter israel on that very day. We went to the border site of the Jordan River where Jesus took baptism. We could see the sign board of the baptism site but we were told that it was one of their Jews festivals that day so the gate was already closed . So we returned to Amman, the City of Jordan and spent the night in the Country of Jordan. In this city we saw a few churches existing from a long time back.

The Next day in April 2018, the first place we visited was Mount Nebo (pishgah Mountain), the place where Israel people journeyed and complained against God and Moses so the Lord sent serpents and bit the people and many of them died on the way. So Moses prayed for the people. The Lord said make a fiery serpent and set it on a pole and whoever looks at it shall live. So he did it. (Numbers 21: 5-9). Here in this very place, the serpent pole is there, and nearby a bog hall is there. Anybody can come pray there, from this place we can see the Jordan plain where the people of Israel are doing all kind of agriculture activities.

We also came across a place called Gelpuwa mountain. The place where David Goliath fought. While going through the plain area, we saw some Palestinian shepherded field.

Then we came across the sea of Galilee. Here in one hotel, they were selling Peter's fish. So we had lunch here and tasted Peter's fish. I could collect the leftover fish and dry it and bring it to Nagaland and let many of our friends here in Nagaland taste it.

We also could come across the place where Jesus fed five thousand people with five loaves and two fishes. (John 6:5-13).

Not very far from here there is a place called Sea of Galilee, also known as the lake of Gennesaret (a fresh water lake from Israel) where Peter and the others went fishing but got nothing. When they met Jesus, He asked them to throw their net on the right side. But Peter said we labored the whole night but got nothing but because of your word I will throw once more and when he did, they caught one hundred fifty three fishes at one time and their net was about to break. (John 21:4-14) / (Luke 5:1-11).

We also came to the place of Capernaum, where Jesus was inside the house. And because of too many people, a paralyzed person was carried by four men and they dropped him from the roof of the house in front of Jesus. And Jesus healed him (Luke 5:17-39).

We also have come to a place of Capernaum, where Jesus taught the multitudes and his disciples on 9 (nine) points of being blessed (Matthew 5:3-12).

We also come to a place where Jesus was transfigured before Peter, James and John. and Peter said, "Lord, it is good for us to be here. If thou wilt, I will put up three tabernacles; one for you and one for Moses and one for Elias." (Matthew 17:1 - 8).

We also came to Canna village, where Jesus turned water into wine. (John 2: 1-11). Here we saw some people were having weddings in two places.

We were taken to a place where people rejected Jesus. And Jesus said a prophet has no honour in his own place (John 4:44).

Then we also came to a place where angel Gabriel met Mary and said fear not Mary for thou hast found favour with God. and told about the birth of Jesus. (Luke 1:26-38).

We also could see Mount Carmel on the left side of the road which we went through.

We also came to the place where Prophet Elijah challenged 450 prophets of Baal and got victory by burning the altar of sacrifice. (1 king 18 recorded).

We also came to the place where Jesus was tempted after 40 days of fasting (Matthew 4:1-11). Again we went to Jericho road where Zacchaeus met Jesus from the sycamore tree (Luke 19: 1-10).

We also could see a portion of fallen Jericho wall which was mentioned in Joshua Chapter 6. We also came to the place where the shepherds were watching their flock by night and the angel came and told them about the birth of Jesus Christ. This place they called it Shepherd's Field. (Luke 2:8-20).

We also come to the Jordan river where Jesus took water baptism (Matthew 3:16-17). Our group all went inside the river and came out. We also could come across the place where Jesus was born in a stable of Bethlehem (Luke 2:7-22).

We also went to the house of Mary and Martha. And also to Lazaarus's graveyard where Jesus came and raised him up. (John 11:1-44).

We also went to Elizabeth's place/house where John was born (John 1:21-36) / (Luke 1:36-44).

We also come across so upper room where Jesus had the passover feast with his disciples (Matthew 26:26-30)

We also went to Gethsemane garden where Jesus prayed and said watch and pray, lest you fall into temptation (Mat. 26:36-41). Here we could see the oldest Olive tree which was there during Jesus time and is still alive in this garden of Gethsemane.

We also could see the thorn tree which was used to make a crown and put on Jesus' head.

Then we came to Caiaphas (High Priest) house and also St. Peter Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times (Matthew 26:34). And also saw the cavalry road which was closed and no longer in use now. After that we went to the garden tomb. Here we had a wonderful time having the Lord's supper. We also went to a ship on the Nile River and had dinner inside the ship in the River Nile.

We also went to see the place where Jesus was taken up to heaven while he was just talking with them and blessed them (Luke 24:50-53).

While coming to Egypt from Israel on the way we had lunch. And in this Hotel all decorations were pictures and statues of cows. And they said that in this area there is a dairy factory and we

can get all kinds of milk products. And this place is the place where God showed a well of water to Hagar and her son Ismael called Beersheba. (Genesis 21:14-21).

We also could see the Sea of Galilee, Mediterranean Sea, Dead Sea (Here we collected water, salt blocks and mud) and red sea.

When we halted one night on the way to Egypt to climb up Sinai Mountain we started by 10 pm and returned by 6 am the next morning. Here the Ten Commandments was brought (Exodus 19 & 20).

In Cairo, Egypt, we were shown a pyramid museum where dead bodies were preserved including mummies of the King's bodies. We also saw how they were making handmade paper, exacting different kinds of anointing oils and perfumes. And also we were shown some old churches and mosques and synagogues. And also the place where Joseph and Mary took Jesus and lived for three months in Egypt when King Herod killed all the children of two years and below (Matthew 2 : 13 - 21).
