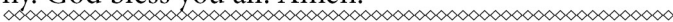
I am now studying for a Diploma in Theology at IMTC

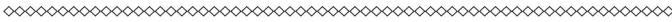

I came to Kohima to attend Billy Graham Crusade in the year 1972, in the month of February. I took my decision in that Crusade, after what God showed me to do for young people (Teenagers Evangelism of Nagaland) on second Sunday of March 1972. So I wrote a letter to Billy Graham Evangelistic Association that I would like to start a ministry among the teenagers. They printed my letter in their Decision Magazine in their September issue. And the editor mentioned just below my letter, requesting all the readers of Decision Magazine to pray for the young people of Nagaland, as they start Teenagers Evangelism of Nagaland. After seeing that I was more burdened to start the (T.E.N.) ministry. The first T.E.N. magazine came out on 8th February, 1976. And the first Teenager's day was observed in Botsa Baptist Church on second Sunday of March, 1977. The second Teenager's day was observed at Terogunyu, Rengma Village on second Sunday, March 14th, 1982. After completing ten (10) years of service, we changed from Nagaland into Nations, i.e, Teenagers Evangelism of Nagaland into Teenagers Evangelism of the Nations (T.E.N.).

OUTREACH REPORT

1. November 30 to 7 December 2023, we the IMTC students and staff could go and did two things together. Day time we gave training on basket making and five fingers knitting and every evening gospel service. The trainees were from Gelephu Bhutan and Hathigoar of Assam.
2. We also could go and did an agreement deed for the International Prayer Garden at Noah Park Hathidunga, Raigoan Nepal on 5th December 2023.
3. United Council Revival Churches & Ministry conference was held from 10-12 January 2024 at Chumuokedima, Nagaland. A few people were given licence reversent and commission certificates.
4. From 4th to 10th February 2024, 17 of us went to the proposed site of International Prayer Garden Hathidunga, Raigoan Nepal and started construction of the first prayer house.
5. At Mr. Lalit's place of Satari District, there were two Christian families and they gave a small plot for construction of prayer home fellowship. So we went and purchased bamboo and cut by ourselves and carried and started construction of prayers home. Villagers asked Mr. Lalit, "what are you doing with these foreigners people working like us in our village?" Mr. Lalit replied, "These people are from Nagaland and they want to help us in construction of prayer home. And they will teach our children with English etc." The villagers were so happy, that they will send their children for learning English and singing.
6. We also went up to Chankadewa Park, Dhankuta, Nepal, which was run by the Christian people. There we started putting the post for construction of United Christian Prayer Centre (UCPC). This place is very high altitude, very cold and windy, where many tourist use to come.

7. From 25 to 29 February 2024, we went to Christian Pentecostal Church and Eternal Hope Prayer Centre (E-HOPE) Dhulabari Charali, Nepal. We also did the foundation stone at the place for construction of United Prayer Centre. We also had a wonderful meeting with their leaders of Global Outreach Ministry.

8. From 11 to 16 April 2024, we had been to Jarkhand, given (five) of them water baptism, given 25 students of 3 months certificates. 4 places were donated to construct United Christian Prayer Centre at Jamshedpur city and around of Jarkhand.

9. On April 21, 2024, we went to Dalisamalhuri, Titabor, Jorhat District, Assam for opening a new UCPC church through Evangelist Norest

10. On 2nd May 2024, by God's grace, a Bible graduates and M Div. person by the name Miss Dim of Mizo, who completed her studies from here in Nagaland and was sent as a missionary teacher to the place of International Prayer garden Hathigoar Raigoan Nepal.

11. During 16 to 18 June 2024, 11 of us IMTC could go and do the work of United Christian Prayer Centre (UCPC) at Bogijan of Chokihola Karbi Anglong, Assam. Land was donated by Pastor Anil & family.

12. Pastor Mahindra Tawa, Mrs. Hena, and Pastor Babul were given License and Commission certificates on 17th June 2024 at Nagaland Women Prayer Centre. They all were from Nepal. They are doing great work for God through global outreach ministry.
